## 5 Lakh Employees to Benefit LTC in Vande Bharat Train

### Another State Govt Decision for Employees, Know Rules and Norms for Travel



Ahmedabad  
Chief Minister Bhupendra Patel has taken an important decision to recognize Vande Bharat train travel for holiday travel relief for state government employees. Benefit of LTC/Vataan tour is given to State Government employees every four years within the limit of 6000 km. Employees travel by train as per such itinerary. Then the government employees can now also do this journey in Vande Bharat train. 5 lakh government employees will

benefit from this journey.

What are the rules and norms?

This provision is for actual travel by Rajdhani/Shatabdi/Vande Bharat Express train. Both the starting point of the journey and the final destination of the journey should be directly connected by Rajdhani/Shatabdi/Vande Bharat Express train.

This provision is not to be relied upon for computing notional rent.

Railway fare including breakfast/meal is charged by

the railway authorities in the trains. They will be entitled to full fare including breakfast/meal.

A Government servant whose family as defined for the purpose of leave travel relief resides away from his place of work shall visit his native place or any place alone once in every year instead of availing the home travel relief for himself and his family once in a period of four years. He can avail such relief for himself. Interpretation of visit to any place If the employee's family resides in any other place other than his native place, the place has to be interpreted accordingly and the employee has to submit the evidence that his family resides in such a place.

Vande Bharat train was introduced to provide benefits of travel by Indian Railways for the last few years, Vande Bharat train with modern facilities has been started.

## Kamraj Primary School Rs. Launched at a cost of 3.70 crores

## The smallest of the mosquito has the power to infect our bodies

World Mosquito Day is observed every year on August 20 to commemorate Sir Ronald Ross's discovery in 1897 that Anopheles mosquitoes transmit the malaria parasite to humans. Malaria is a mosquito borne infectious disease affecting both humans and animals, causing millions of deaths annually. The focus of the event is to highlight the need to maintain the efforts towards elimination of malaria and seek commitment from political parties and other stakeholders. Despite the efforts of global community, malaria epidemic is far from being completely eradicated with a gradual increase in the number of affected and dead, every year. It is estimated that every two minutes a child dies due to malaria, across the globe. Malaria has also severe consequences on the health and economy of a nation.

Observance of the World

Mosquito Day reignites the resolve of governments and general public to fight malaria and seek its elimination. It also helps the campaigns in garnering technical, logistical and financial support to push forward the fight against malaria. The first symptoms of malaria appear within ten to fifteen days of getting bitten by an infected mosquito. Initial symptoms include high fever, chills, weakness and headache. When untreated, the symptoms can escalate causing serious illnesses, leading to death.

Today, the best way to prevent the disease is to avoid bites by infected mosquitoes. The most important method of preventing malaria is by controlling the spread of its carriers, that is Anopheles mosquitoes. There are around four hundred species of Anopheles mosquitoes, out of which only 30 are potential carriers of malaria parasites.

Mosquitoes, those tiny blood-sucking insects, are responsible for transmitting serious diseases such as malaria. With no vaccine currently available, malaria - an ancient disease that began afflicting humans from the beginning of agriculture and modern civilization - remains a deadly threat to people around the world. Malaria disease is one of the worst public health crises the country

has ever faced, endangering one in every six Indians. Death can occur in as little as three days if an FP infection is not properly treated. Nearly 50,000 people die in the country every year due to complications of the disease. While travelling to a malaria endemic zone, anti-malarial tablets may be prescribed to prevent contracting malaria. Immediate diagnosis and treatment can help prevent complications and death. Every time a case of malaria is reported, a mapping exercise is undertaken to intensify fog and spray the pesticides in all surrounding areas. Malaria is preventable as well as treatable, yet the disease claims nearly half a million lives each year. The deaths are mainly attributed to not taking preventive measures and delayed diagnosis. People in lower economic class and remote areas; don't understand the risk of malaria, unless they get infected. Not using mosquito nets or insecticides only escalates the spread of disease. Though an infectious disease, whether a person contracts malaria or not, also depends substantially on how clean the surrounding environments are. One of the major causes of mosquito breeding is water stagnation. Its rather shocking that Indians having knowledge about the excellent benefits of Neem and

cowdung, has not done any research towards the same, in the prevention of malaria.

According to the last World Malaria Report released on 19th November 2018, an estimated 219 million cases of malaria have been reported in the preceding year, causing nearly half a million deaths globally. African countries were the most affected, by being home to 92% of the global malaria cases and 93% of casualties due to malaria.

Though, India accounts for only 4% of total malaria cases reported globally, unfortunately it also accounts for 52% of the total malaria deaths caused outside the African region. India has set a target of eradicating malaria by the year 2030.

Despite the commendable efforts by the World Health Organization, respective governments and other relevant bodies in fighting malaria, the global campaign against malaria is facing an acute financial crunch. Eliminating malaria is, and should be the top priority. Grand pronouncements are meaningless as long as manipulated data twist our knowledge and bad governance impedes genuine attempts to fight the disease. **(B-15 Jyoti-Kalash Society, Jodhpur Tekra, Satellite, Ahmedabad - 380 015)**

## Bus carrying 30 passengers falls into pit

While people are losing their lives in accidents everyday in the state, one more incident has come to light from Surendranagar. More than 20 passengers were injured when ST bus carrying 30 passengers fell into a pit here. However, fortunately no one died in this incident. At present, the police have shifted all the injured under treatment and are conducting further investigation. According to the news, the bus overturned in the pothole near Patia of Somasar village on the



Surendranagar-Chotila highway. The driver of the ST bus on the Rajkot-Surendranagar route lost control of the steering and the

bus overturned in the pothole down the road. There were about 30 passengers in this bus, out of which more than 20 passengers were injured.

## Political Tribute in Tribal Youth Murder Case

Narmada : Two local tribal youths were beaten to death by the men of the contractor working on the tribal museum under construction near Kevadia after they were suspected of theft. In opposition to this incident, opposition forces including Aam Aadmi Party, Congress have announced Kevadia bandh on Tuesday and organized a program to pay tribute to the dead in public. At that time, Chaitar Vasava, who was coming to a tribute program at Kevadia, was stopped by the police at Bogaj village in Dediapada and the police have



taken shelter at Anant Patel's house and put him under house arrest. Also, as Congress leader and former opposition leader Sukhram Rathwa was going to Kevadia today, the Kavant police detained him from the road. The incident at the Narmada Adivasi Museum is taking a political shape.

Today on August 13, a tribute program has been held in Kevadia by Congress and AAP. In which the tribal leaders from across the state are to come, the Narmada administrative system and the police were both busy. Then before this program, the family of both the deceased released a video that we are not going to attend this tribute program. If more people gather and any untoward incident happens, then it is not our responsibility after this video went viral, the politics in Narmada district got heated again.

## Health department in Surat conducts sampling of mawa vendors before festival

Surat

Surtialas, who are fond of food and drink, are known for serving different types of sweets on festivals. Many a times doubts arise on the quality of maava used in sweetmeats. Eating inedible fruits can also harm health. Keeping this in mind, the health department has started action. In which the procedure was carried out to take samples by reaching the mawa sellers in different zones of the city.

Sampling started in different zones  
The team of Health Department of Surat Municipal Corporation today started taking samples by going to sweets sellers and mawa sellers within 8 zones of the city. Mava is also sold separately in dairies as well as in sweet shops. Many people make sweets at home by bringing their own mao instead of buying sweets from a sweet shop. The health department only visited places



selling mava and also took samples of mava from dairy and sweet shops.

The report will come after 14 days.

The health officer said that today the samples of mava sellers have been started from different places of the city. The sample taken is sent to a public health laboratory.

A report on the quality of the mother is usually received within fourteen days. However, we have insisted that the report be given sooner than 14 days, so that action can be taken against any adulterated sample.

To put it directly, the number of traders and brokers is 15 to 18 thousand.

## In Vadodara, a student was crushed by a truck driver

Vadodara : On the other hand, a student studying in class 12 was killed when a speeding icer truck hit the students who were going on Activa in Kareligha area of Vadodara. The entire accident on four roads was captured on CCTV. In this incident, the student driver, who was taking a turn, was hit by the driver of the truck coming from behind. In which a student's hand and nose started bleeding when the tire of the

truck rolled over her. The minor died before receiving treatment. Kareligha police have arrested the truck driver and started further investigation in this matter.

It is worth mentioning that the student, who died in an accident, was supposed to go to America within a month of getting a 10-year visa, but the truck that had turned out to be overcrowded. A 17-year-old student living in Gorwa area of
